In a first-of-its-kind initiative, the City of Vaughan is leading a collaboration to transform an 82-acre parcel of land at Jane Street and Major Mackenzie Drive into the Vaughan Healthcare Centre Precinct (VHCP). Together with partners Mackenzie Health, York University and ventureLAB, the City is developing a world-class destination for healthcare excellence on the lands surrounding the site of the Cortellucci Vaughan Hospital, Canada's first smart hospital. Collectively, each member organization's expertise and physical co-location in the partnership provide an opportunity to leverage cross-disciplinary knowledge, allowing the VHCP to emerge as a leading medical innovation node.

The VHCP will be a **leading medical innovation hub**, representing a collaboration between top educators, researchers, practitioners and business incubators. The VHCP will have a broad mandate encompassing community health innovation in the social, technological and business spheres. It will be a destination of choice for **research**, **education**, **innovation**, **commercialization and services** in healthcare delivery, informatics and wellness, focused on a unique "care without walls" approach.

Innovation Corridor TTC Transit: Vaughan to Union Station (TRAVEL TIME: 42 minutes)




Vaughan is a city positioned for success


Here are some of the reasons the city of Vaughan is an optimum destination for health and health-technology companies:

The VHCP is connected to major transportation assets in Vaughan.


The city of Vaughan:

- has direct access to Highways 427, 400 and 407 and is minutes away from Highways 401, 404 and 410.
- is connected to rail service via the Canadian National (CN) MacMillan Yard, the Canadian Pacific (CP) Railway Vaughan Intermodal Terminal and the passenger rail service via the Maple and Rutherford stations on GO Transit's Barrie line.
- has subway service via three stations on the Toronto Transit
 Commission's Line 1.
- has access to non-stop flights on 75 carriers to 180 destinations worldwide via Toronto Pearson International Airport — Canada's busiest airport — located within 10 kilometres of Vaughan's southwestern boundary.

The VHCP will be an epicentre for collaborative development of next-generation solutions to policy-based, technology and systemic healthcare challenges.



Collaborative Goals

Translating research and innovation to policy and practice, improving quality of care and enabling "care without walls"

Research collaboration between Mackenzie Health clinicians and York University faculty from a broad spectrum of disciplines will generate new approaches to acute care. This includes understanding multiple diseases in one patient simultaneously in terms of prevention, management and rehabilitation of injuries, chronic conditions and post-surgical treatments.

Leverage data analytics, machine learning and smart technology to advance efficiency and quality of care

Pair the hospital's smart technology and solutions developed by ventureLAB companies with York University's data analytics and machine learning expertise to advance the quality and efficiency of care.

Commercialization of innovative health technologies

Collaboration between Mackenzie Health, York University and ventureLAB to foster co-operation and co-development between private sector/entrepreneurs and clinicians/hospital administration, and to incubate and scale innovative health technologies.

Preparing the health workforce of the future

Creating experiential and integrated learning opportunities to train the next generation of healthcare professionals to utilize modern, world-class practices and to be proficient with the latest technologies.
